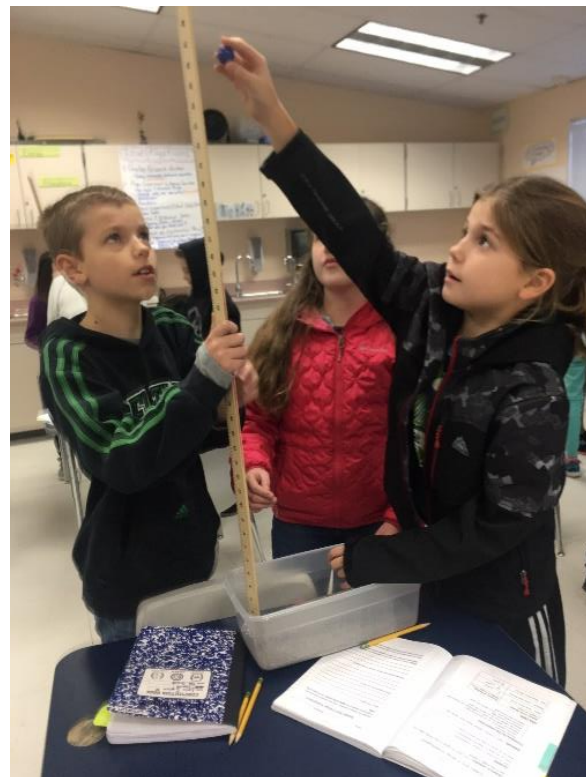
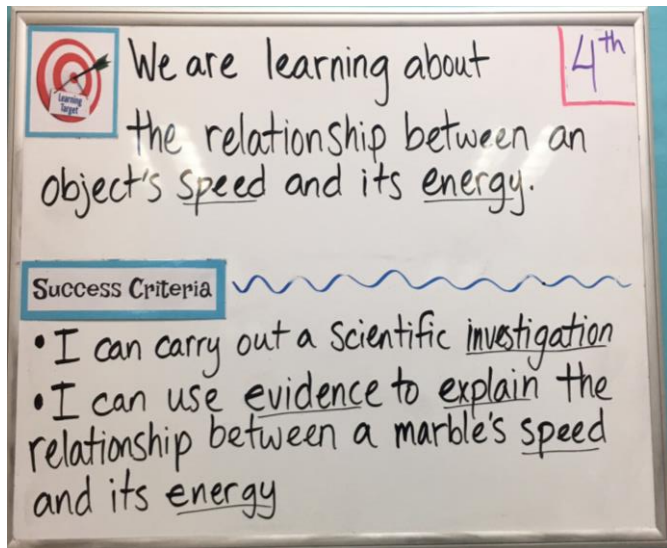

- Be specific in your submission; photos can be included if appropriate

- Include your contact information if you would like a response
